MOTOR VEHICLE EXCISE TAX

The first excise tax bills for calendar 2016 have be mailed to owners of vehicles garaged in Shutesbury.

In order to receive an abatement the owner **must** document **two** things.

- 1. Return of the license plate
- 2. transfer ownership of the vehicle.

If you have sold or traded a vehicle recently and received a tax bill for that vehicle you can apply for an abatement for a portion of the year. We will issue a pro-rated abatement upon receipt of all materials required by law.

- bill of sale (if sold) or trade in documentation (if traded), or handwritten bill of sale.
- plate return receipt or copy of new car registration showing plate transfer.
