NEW POLE MOUNTED SOLAR ARRAY GOING UP BEHIND THE FIRE STATION

Our Green Communities Grant dollars will be hard at work for us soon. Each ray of sun will offset the town's electrical consumption. The new system is larger than the one at town hall. Town hall is a 10 kW system and the new one in the field behind the fire station is 15 kW. For much of the year it is expected to cover the electricity needs of both the fire department and the highway department. We hit ledge digging the test pits. Holes had to be 8 feet deep to secure the 21' galvanized steel poles. Rodney Bemis from Vermont sent his drill crew down to solve the problem. The drill bit was 17.5 inches. This hole, hole number 3 had the densist rock formation. When they were done the hole was ringed with white sand, rock pulverized by the drill. The poles were fit into the holes and jigs held them straight. The highway department moved them into place and aligned them. This coming week the panels will be mounted. Most of the electrical work is already done.
