

**SHUTESBURY CONSERVATION COMMISSION  
PUBLIC LEGAL NOTICE – Notice of Intent**

The Shutesbury Conservation Commission has scheduled a public hearing for your Notice of Intent for \_\_\_\_\_ at \_\_\_\_\_ p.m. at the Shutesbury Town Hall.

You are required to place a legal notice in a local daily newspaper (*The Daily Hampshire Gazette* or *Greenfield Recorder*) informing the public of the meeting. The notice must appear **one time at least five business days before your hearing**. You are responsible for paying the cost of the notice.

The text of the legal notice should be approximately as follows:

You will also need to notify all abutters (including those across public rights of way, town lines, and waterways) of the time and place of the hearing, either in writing by Certificate of Mailing or in person.
