

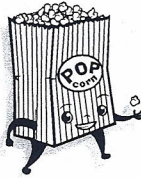
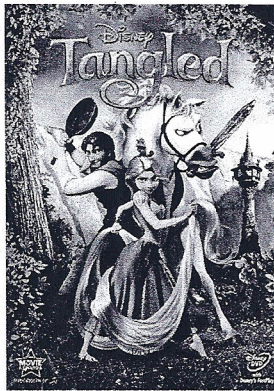

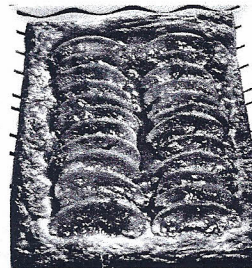
Learn to Make Puff Pastry!

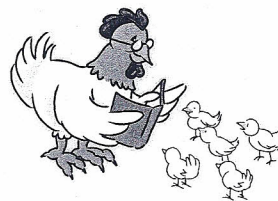
