- 4. Review Storm Water Runoff Mitigation Report

The report contains seven recommendations for mitigating erosion and flooding problems caused by runoff that is carried by and across Locks Pond Road. Water that flows directly onto the main travel lanes is especially hazardous in the wintertime when daytime melting can potentially refreeze on the principal travel lanes.

The following summarizes the seven categories of recommendations:

- a) Diverting driveway runoff away from roadway travel lanes and diverting runoff on the association roads by constructing water bars/diversion ridges, trench drains or broad based dips
- b) Building a storm water retention basin at the intersection of King Road and Great Pine Drive
- c) Building an extended detention pond to capture and temporarily store storm water runoff from portions of Morse Hill and redirect it directly into the Sawmill River.
- d) Increase the size and line the roadside ditch on the west side of Locks Pond Road with a Turf-reinforced mat lining.
- e) Crown Lake Drive and add a small ditch on the west side
- f) Add rain barrels to capture rooftop runoff
- g) Build a Leaching Basin at the intersection of Great Pine Drive and Lake Drive.
