Select Board Action Items

- 1. Selectmen signed payroll warrants totaling \$78,546.04.
- 2. Selectmen signed vendor warrants totaling \$229,438.86.

Topics the Chairman Could Not Reasonably Have Anticipated

- 1. The erratic weather and flood consequences including closed streets and highways which are clogging open streets and sights.
- 2. Al reported that he and Fire Chief Tibbetts had inspected the wetlands near the fire station yesterday:
 - a. There is no oil sheen on the wetlands by the fire station.
 - b. The water is clean and the frogs are jumping in.
 - c. O'Reilly, Talbot & Okun consultant Jim Okun will start the water testing next week.
- 3. Lake Wyola Dam: To protect citizens when there is a high flow of water through the sluice gate.
 - a. Should the Selectboard support purchase for emergency professional signage and buoys to be stored at the gatehouse for emergencies during high water situations.
 - b. Bids are not yet in for the professional sign.
 - c. Fire Chief and Emergency Management Director Tibbetts has already made up buoys with use of red swimming noodles and colored rope.
 - d. Selectmen are missing Regional School Superintendent Maria Geryk's school opening event due to this meeting.
- 4. During the meeting a call came in for Town Administrator Torres from the current Town Hall Custodian stating that due to his full time employment he needed to resign his position.
- 5. Selectmen agreed to meet at 6PM on Tuesday, September 6 for last minute preparations for the September 10 Ball.
