1. Review road issues around Lake Wyola that are causing sediment (sand, silt, etc.) contamination in the lake include:
 - a. The most critical roads where sediment runoff is greatest is Great Pines Drive which accumulates runoff from Haskins Way and to a lesser extent, Locks Pond Road. Most of this runoff is directed onto Lake Drive.
 - b. Also significant, is water/sediment flow from Wendell Road flowing down South Laurel.
 - c. Additional runoff and sediment on sections of Shore Drive is concentrated, entering the lake at one location due to culvert blocking.
2. Develop a corrective action plan.
 - a. Is action needed before winter snow plowing begins?
3. Identify potential short and long term funding sources?
