Latex Paint Disposal

Based on the type of paint product requiring disposal, one of the following two procedures is recommended:

Latex and acrylic paints are potentially hazardous to the environment in their liquid form. In order to safely dispose of them, purchase paint hardener at an area paint or building supply store (such as Amherst Farmer's Supply or Cowls). Compile unwanted paint from partially full cans into a single paint can and stir in the powder as directed. Allow to completely harden in a well-ventilated area (do not cover). Alert your trash hauler that the paint in the can is no longer in liquid form as paint cans are red flags for waste collection employees. If you bring dried-out paint to the transfer station, leave the lids off so attendants may verify that the paint is completely dry (disposal fees apply). Do not place unverified paint cans into blue Town of Amherst bags. Several scoops of kitty litter may be used as an alternative to the hardener, but the drying process will take much longer.

All other forms of paint and paint products may be taken to the Town's annual hazardous household waste collection (pre-registration required). This includes: oil paint, paint in aerosol cans, paint thinner, linseed oil, turpentine, wood stains and preservatives. Amherst will not sponsor another event until Fall 2026.
