Vaccination news:

Vaccine supply remains severely limited.

The state has announced a preregistration system for the seven mass vaccination sites in Massachusetts; the nearest such site to us is Eastfield Mall in Springfield. This system will go live tomorrow, March 12, at an unspecified time. If you are eligible for vaccination now and can travel to Springfield or beyond, this system can take a lot of of the stress – and the time – out of trying to get an appointment. People who lack internet access can call 2-1-1 for help getting preregistered. If you wish, you can still use <a href="https://www.mass.gov">waxfinder.mass.gov</a> to search for an appointment at another venue.

Vaccine for the homebound: To qualify for in-home vaccination a person must be unable to leave home without the assistance of two people and/or an ambulance. To our knowledge, there is no such person in Shutesbury.
