SMLP and its agents, subcontractors and employees shall have the right to enter the Customer’s (outside) Property at all reasonable times for the purpose of installing, inspecting, maintaining or repairing SMLP telecommunications network. Permission is also granted at any time for emergency maintenance or repair. Any work done affecting in-home (inside) installation or underground installations will be required to be approved by the homeowner via a work order and prior permission of the homeowner.

If Customer has existing communications conduit, the Customer grants SMLP a license to use the communications conduit located on the Customer’s property. In consideration of the installation, the Customer agrees to indemnify and hold harmless and defend SMLP and its agent, subcontractors and employees from any and all claims due to damage, losses or expenses arising directly or indirectly out of damage to the communications conduit or other communications equipment located therein.
