Minutes of May 1 and May 15 approved.

6 Great Pines Drive Extension, ZB-15: DWCP application for septic tank repair or replace. CK's memo recommends approval. The board agreed to issue the permit (2019-04-0601) with the condition that the tank should be replaced, not repaired.

Lot Q-41, West Pelham Road, Habitat for Humanity: DWCP, new system. The board voted that CH will issue the permit (2019-04-0602) on receipt of the fee.

32 Lake Drive, B-93: request for exemption from Title 5 inspection requirement. The property is changing hands in a cash sale; the new owner intends to raze the cottage. The variance is granted on the condition that the septic system is declared to be in failure. Letter to interested parties.

Discussion:

With Sarah Todd, RN, of Leverett BOH, the board discussed a town-wide mailing regarding the recent measles outbreak. Leverett BOH has included a letter regarding measles vaccination in its town newsletter, in press, and Northampton Public Health Dept. has issued a measles alert press release. Our mailing will outline the nature of measles, its transmission and prevention, and the rules of quarantine for those who contract it.
