1. Take Attendence

- 2. The Broadband Committee letter to be put in the town wide mailing "Our Town" has been revised by removing any reference to a future election and submitted in time to be included.
- 3. The Committee must be sure that items funded by the Friends of Broadband are labeled as such.
- 4. Steve, then Gayle will give the brief information session about the fiber broadband project to the Select Board's two info sessions, one from 3 to 5pm on 4/22, the other from 7 to 9pm on 4/29, prior to Town Meeting.
- 5. The Finance Committee will give a brief description of the town's financial health to start off the Town Meeting.
- 6. Three to four hundred people are expected at Town Meeting, but it could be substantially more. Parking is a problem; one side of West Pelham Rd only. Walk, bike ride, carpool.

- 7. Be sure to sign in to Town Meeting so you'll be able to vote
- 8. MBI has a new number for our "not to exceed" bonding obligation: \$1,693,200. (\$1.67 million plus 2% for bonding cost.
- 9. The bonding itself is a one time event, usually occurring at or near the end of the build out project. But the project financing goes through many stages prior to the bonding.
- 10. For the median priced premise, \$243,000, the worst case scenario would be under \$13 per month on the tax bill. The best case would be to never have a tax increase.
- 11. At this date, Leverett has not yet gone out to bond, and has spent about \$6,000 so far.
- 12. The next meeting will be on 4/20 from 6 to 8 pm. Bill Stathis from Crocker Communications will present at 6:30 pm.
- 13. On 4/21 at 6:30 pm there is an open to the public Q and A at the Leverett Town Hall about the Leverett experience.
- 14. On 4/23 at 6 pm, MBI will host a community outreach at the Swift River School in New Salem.
