- 2) New burials, installations of stones, lot sales:
 - a. The cremain burial of Ellen Howell in the Howell lot took place on August
 14. WT gave the family the information sheet for cremain burials and as a result, WT's responsibilities were able to go smoothly.
 - <u>b.</u> Negus and Taylor have the stone for the Kennersons ready for installation.

 - 2. The next step is painting the pins.
 - 3. Markers need to be added to the s-curve area on Road 5. WT found working there on the last cremain burial pretty confusing.
