### Joint Meeting of SCC with Leverett and Wendell Conservation Commissions to discuss a shared

**Conservation Agent:** Leverett CC and Wendell CC have both had a part-time, unbenefited Conservation Agent (CA) position held by Kohl, who will be stepping down in the spring. LCC and WCC have found it very helpful having a Conservation Agent. These positions require technical experience and are not just administrative positions. It is difficult to fill part-time, unbenefited positions. CAs typically write permits, conduct site visits and delineations, and prepare regulatory documents. All three CCs have a potential interest in a shared Agent position. Shutesbury does not have a Conservation Agent, only a nonprofessional Land Use Clerk position. SCC has experienced turnover in its staffing and had difficulty filling the last vacancy in 2021. Various models for a shared position were discussed. FRCOG has been studying a shared, multi-town model. There is considerable interest among Franklin County Conservation Commissions. Timing and coordination are a challenge as WCC and LCC are currently anticipating a vacancy in March and SCC does not have an approved CA position at present. Towns cannot also share resumes during recruitment. A joint position would require an inter-municipal agreement and approval of salary/benefits across the three towns. SCC would need to have a CA job description approved by the Personnel Board and then have a budget line approved by Town Meeting for a new position. Three Commissions agree to continue studying issue.
