- Able to interview, separately, 7 members of the Fire Department and 1 by phone.
- Take away from what was shared by Fire Fighters:
- Shutesbury has a strong Fire Department-the town has the right model for our Fire Department
- Department members support having a FT Fire Chief
- Support for finding ways to increase the number of volunteers on the force
- Discussed some ideas as to how to increase the volunteers-Kristen planning a civilian open house for the Police Department at some point. Perhaps there's a way to combine with the Fire Department. Discussed a possible Public Safety Day. It was noted that this would be difficult with Covid at this time.
- Information from other Fire Departments
- Leverett is in a transition, according to Walter, though nothing has been formalized at this point. Appear to be moving towards a FT Chief.
- Erving, Wendell, New Salem and Pelham all pay their Fire Fighters for responding to calls in addition to training.
- Pelham does not have a FT chief, though, according to Walter, appear to be moving in the direction of having a FT Chief.
- Over past decade towns have generally been moving toward having their own FT Chief.
- Current Shutesbury Fire Chief's job description does not require the Chief to live in town, however the employment contract does.
- Shutesbury's current job description has the Chief's position as "exempt" from overtime.

- Becky will send out Town Announce asking for questions from citizens and inviting people to the Public Forum. The announcement will invite people to look at the town website for the Committee's Charge, minutes and summary
- Questions will be sent to Kristen/Becky. They will forward those to Elaine
