Gail Fleischaker on the web committee also wants to know if we would put something on our website, an interactive map of the NE Trail, ten miles of which go through Shutesbury.

People want to know about swim lessons at the beach. We have never done that, it is a private arrangement with the instructor.

Celebrate Shutesbury: we have declined to run it in the past and can't take it on now. Someone will need to take it over if it is to continue. A committee dedicated to this event might be a good idea as it is a major responsibility.

We currently have no involvement with exercise classes, after having handled them during the wintertime for a couple of years. The library now handles those classes entirely. Funds from our budget have gone into those classes.

Our budget: We have no current expenses. Our budget currently has \$1000.

Barbara: Nuestras Raices in Holyoke supports tenant farmers, helps launch small businesses, and is very active in issues of food insecurity. They specialize in growing food central to Latin American cuisine, and also have a commercial kitchen, classes in entrepreneurship, and many other activities. They have expertise in community gardens, we may have information or other resources that is of use to them, and we could possibly connect with them. Barbara will contact them on behalf of the committee.
