Approval of Minutes

• Minutes from the September 25, 2012 meeting were approved.

Free at the Side of the Road (FSR) Policy

- Gary explained the three cases of items being left on the side of the road that police need to investigate:
 - Left after residents move
 - o Remain after FSR week and Bulky Waste Day (BWD)
 - Illegal dumping
- Gary will edit illegal dumping protocol that was drafted by Paul Vlach and will share it with the Committee for comment
- Subcommittee of Gary, Meryl and Peg will meet on this issue with:
 - Police Chief
 - o Town Administrator
 - Highway Department Chief
 - Selectboard Member (if possible)
- Electronic forums not sponsored by the town (Neighborhood Shutesbury, eCricket) might be used for offering services (e.g., pickup truck) to bring items to BWD. Meryl offered to post a notice regarding BWD pickup on eCricket and Neighborhood Shutesbury.
- Gary will improve advertising of FSR and the need to remove them after BWD

Paper Shredding Event

- Gary arranged for Valley Green Shredders to be at the Farmers Market on June 15 since they were not available on BWD
- They shred material that they sell for a profit
- Donations for the Senior Center improvements will be suggested from participating residents

Trash Bag Distribution

- The schedule for Committee workers has been filled in well
- Bags are in the elementary school shed where most distribution will occur
- Landlords must inform the town to have their name entered into the distribution book if they don't want their tenants to pick up bags

Bulky Waste Day

 Gary will email potential volunteers and contact the Salvation Army regarding electronics and cloth recycling

- Meryl to place BWD signs around town the week before BWD
- CFCs items will be decommissioned and trash roll-offs removed the day of the event
- Gary will serve as yard boss
- Stop-Slow paddles for traffic control will be ordered under a grant

Other

- Grant funds will be used for recycling bins and compost bins
- Recycling bins will be given free to new residents
- The price of Shutesbury tote bags will be reduced from \$3 to \$2
- Meryl will contact the Town Administrator about inserting handouts from town committees into tote bags for distribution to new residents
- There is Committee support for another composting workshop
- Meryl will prepare a one-pager for the town annual report
- Idea for future Trash Talk: freezing waste dairy and meat products before placing in curbside trash to reduce attraction to animals
- No date set for next Committee meeting
