Dear commission members,

Evan Jones has prepared this Notice of Intent (NOI) as the homeowner, for the installation of a permeable stone patio, retaining walls, a deck expansion, and a master bedroom addition. This NOI has no alterations to the Land under Waterbody.

The proposed project is located on a single family houselot on Lake Drive on the southern shoreline of Lake Wyola. The site slopes towards the water and is primarily mown lawn and assorted landscaping/bushes. The site has an existing brick paver patio against the house facing the lake.

The project entails a 24 x 26 foundation to be dug beyond the 50' wetland buffer zone, and a stone patio and two retaining walls within the 50' wetland buffer zone but not encroaching past the 26' mark. An extension of the existing deck will be over the new patio at approximately the 40' mark. The deck will be supported by helical piers screwed into the soil for least ground impact. Installation of straw wattles will be done at the 25' mark as shown on the site plan.

The proposed work will only be within the *buffer zone* of the Land Under Waterbody. Erosion controls will be in place prior to work to protect against siltation of Lake Wyola. There will be no work within 25' of the Land under Waterbody. Any soil stockpiles will be tarped and protected.

Construction plan is to dig and construct foundation, cap the foundation with floor joists and plywood, and then move on to the patio and retaining walls. Screwing in the helical piers would come next and that would be the end of the "landscape disruption" After everything is stabilized, the carpentry work of the addition and deck would commence.

This project should have minimal impact to the lake and to the abutters. I look forward to presenting the project when you are ready.


