Re: Order of Resource Area Delineation Extension Request

Dear Commission Members:

On behalf of the Applicant, W.D. Cowls, Inc., Tetra Tech respectfully requests an Extension of the Order of Resource Area Delineation (ORAD) issued by the Shutesbury Conservation Commission on April 23, 2021 pursuant to the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act (M.G.L. Chapter 131, Section 40) and its Regulations (310 CMR 10.00), and the Town of Shutesbury General Wetlands Protection Bylaw and Regulations.

W.D. Cowls, Inc. continues to evaluate development alternatives at the subject property and a Notice of Intent filing prior to the expiration of the ORAD will not be feasible. It is our opinion that the wetland delineation approved under the ORAD represents the current wetland resource areas, as no substantive changes have been observed at the undeveloped subject property. Per 310 CMR 10.05(8), we respectfully request a three (3) year extension of the Order of Resource Area Delineation to April 23, 2027.

C. Findings

This Order of Resource Area Delineation determines that the boundaries of those resource areas noted above, have been delineated and approved by the Commission and are binding as to all decisions rendered pursuant to the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act (M.G.L. c.131, § 40) and its regulations (310 CMR 10.00). This Order does not, however, determine the boundaries of any resource area or Buffer Zone to any resource area not specifically noted above, regardless of whether such boundaries are contained on the plans attached to this Order or to the Abbreviated Notice of Resource Area Delineation.

This Order must be signed by a majority of the Conservation Commission. The Order must be sent by certified mail (return receipt requested) or hand delivered to the applicant. A copy also must be mailed or hand delivered at the same time to the appropriate DEP Regional Office (see https://www.mass.gov/service-details/massdep-regional-offices-by-community).

D. Appeals

The applicant, the owner, any person aggrieved by this Order, any owner of land abutting the land subject to this Order, or any ten residents of the city or town in which such land is located, are hereby notified of their right to request the appropriate DEP Regional Office to issue a Superseding Order of Resource Area Delineation. When requested to issue a Superseding Order of Resource Area Delineation, the Department's review is limited to the objections to the resource area delineation(s) stated in the appeal request. The request must be made by certified mail or hand delivery to the Department, with the appropriate filing fee and a completed Request for Departmental Action Fee Transmittal Form, as provided in 310 CMR 10.03(7) within ten business days from the date of issuance of this Order. A copy of the request shall at the same time be sent by certified mail or hand delivery to the Conservation Commission and to the applicant, if he/she is not the appellant.

Any appellants seeking to appeal the Department's Superseding Order of Resource Area Delineation will be required to demonstrate prior participation in the review of this project. Previous participation in the permit proceeding means the submission of written information to the Conservation Commission prior to the close of the public hearing, requesting a Superseding Order or Determination, or providing written information to the Department prior to issuance of a Superseding Order or Determination.

The request shall state clearly and concisely the objections to the Order which is being appealed and how the Order does not contribute to the protection of the interests identified in the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act, (M.G.L. c. 131, § 40) and is inconsistent with the wetlands regulations (310 CMR 10.00). To the extent that the Order is based on a municipal bylaw or ordinance, and not on the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act or regulations, the Department of Environmental Protection has no appellate jurisdiction.

These findings are based on the *Leverett West Project Shutesbury, MA Wetland Delineation (Figure 2 Sheet 1-8), revised 4.22.2021.* DEP File # 286-0282.

- 1) The Shutesbury Conservation Commission approves the boundaries of stream banks and bordering vegetated wetlands depicted on the final plan set "Leverett West Project Shutesbury, MA" Figure 2 Sheets 1 through 8, final revision April 22, 2021, on the following condition: if a Notice of Intent is submitted citing the boundaries approved under this ORAD, then current flags shall be renumbered and replaced at the exact geo-referenced location depicted on the final plan in consecutive numeric order.
- 2) The Commission does not approve bank and wetland flags outside the study area. The Commission does approve the MAHW flags outside the study area as depicted on the final plans.
- 3) The following findings concern jurisdictional areas protected by both the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act and the Shutesbury Wetlands Bylaw:
 - The Commission approves 100ft buffer zones within the study area.
 - The Commission approves the S1 stream bank within the study area (Figure 2 sheets 1- 4, Flags 23-31, 33-49.1, 50-52, 54-57, 122-138, 140-141, 143-152)
 - The Commission approves the S2 MAHW flags within the study area (Figure 2 sheets 1- 2, Flags 23-29)
 - The Commission approves the W1 bordering vegetated wetland within the study area (Figure 2 sheets 1-4, Flags 16-24, 26-27, 29-33.1, 34-35, 37-38)
 - The Commission approves the W2 bordering vegetated wetland within the study area (Figure 2 sheets 1- 2, Flags 1-12)
 - The Commission approves the W3 bordering vegetated wetland within the study area (Figure 2 sheets 1 and 5, Flags 1-10, 13-15, 31-39)
- 4) The following findings concern the jurisdictional areas protected by the Shutesbury Wetlands Bylaw:
 - The mapped 100ft buffer zones within the study area are approved by the Commission and protected as resource areas under the bylaw.
- 5) Roaring Brook (referred on the plans as S2) is designated a MA Fish & Wildlife cold water fisheries resource (ID# CFR3420250).
