ANSWERS

1. NO
2. YES
3. NO – contains plastic
4. NO – take to Leverett Transfer Station (LTS)
5. YES – unless it's exceptionally greasy
6. NO – can get caught in recycling machinery: take to Leverett Transfer Station (LTS)
7. NO – too many mixed materials
8. NO – the MRF has banned aerosol cans from recycling bins
9. YES – and clean
10. NO – they can damage the Materials Recycling Facility's (MRF) processing equipment
11. YES – but foil must be basically clean
12. NO – they are small and fall off the recycling sorter at the MRF
13. NO
14. YES or MAYBE – book covers and spines must be removed before recycling
15. YES
16. NO – too big for the bin: take to Leverett Transfer Station (LTS)
17. NO – not recyclable at the curb; large blocks of white Styrofoam are sometimes taken at a special LTS collection
18. MAYBE – not necessarily. The number designates the kind of polymer the item is made of, but our MRF may or may not accept that item
19. NO – contains carbon and/or hazardous wastes
20. NO – the glass is too thick
21. YES – must be clean
22. YES
23. MAYBE – plastic egg cartons go in with containers; paper and Styrofoam cartons are not recyclable but paper cartons can go into a compost pile.
24. MAYBE – only clear plastic cups are recyclable. All others are trash.
25. NO – MRF rules changed and they are no longer accepting shredded paper.
26. NO – recycle these bags at the grocery store; there's usually a barrel near the entrance. Pellet stove pellet bags may be taken to Leverett Transfer Station (LTS).
27. NO – recycle Tyvek envelopes at the grocery store in the plastic bag barrel
28. YES
29. NO
30. No -- both types of light bulbs go in the trash.
31. YES – but must be left on or contained within the container.
32. YES
33. NO – it is prohibited at the MRF because it makes sorting dangerous for the MRF workers. Put in trash but bagged to not slice open the bag.
