Laid out a Township to fulfill a Grant made to Thomas Wells Esq<sup>r</sup> William Richardson and Others which bounds west part on the Town of Hadly and part on Sunderland South on the Qualeat Land East on a Township laid out for Salem North upon the Unappropriated Lands It begins at a West branch of Swift River and runs by the side West 1660 perch with a allowance of about one Chain in thirty thence North along said line 500 perch to Sunderland South line from thence East 590 Perch to said Sunderland Southeast Corner from thence North 18 Degrees East eight miles and Eighty Perch from thence East 18 Degrees South 1053 Perch from thence South <sup>thence East 1053 Perch</sup> ten Degrees West 1980 Perch to a Black Church stand- ing by the side of said West Branch and then down along by said Branch to where it first began In which lines is contained 23676 Acres <sup>or 23640 Acres</sup> the contents of six miles Square with 500 Acres a Grant made to his Excellency Jonatha Belcher Esq<sup>r</sup> and 150 Acres allowed the Ponds that are in it
