In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said town, qualified to vote in elections and town affairs, to meet at **8:30 A.M. on Saturday, 5th day of May** at the Shutesbury Town Hall at one Cooleyville Road in said Shutesbury, in the year Two Thousand and Twelve, then and there to act on the following articles:

Article 1. To see if the Town will vote to transfer \$1,309.02 from free cash to pay prior year bill for Highway Fuel (\$1,309.02), or take any other action relative thereto.

Requires majority vote



Hereof fail not, and make due return of this warrant, with your doings thereon, at the time and place of the meeting.




